Animals

- 52 Welsh pony foals
 - 6-10 months old
- 30 Quarter Horses
 - 2 years old

Conclusions

- Thermal sensor appeared to have potential use for initial screening of body temperature in equids at ambient temperatures >15.6C. (J Am Vet Med Assoc 2008; 233:613-617)
